JOB DESCRIPTION

The roll of the Feline Adoption Assistant is to help potential adopters learn about adoptable cats.

Volunteers will work closely with adoption staff and supervisor.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities

- Going over any paperwork that is on the kennel or colony room.
- Checking that a Guest pass has already been issued to the potential adopter.
- Scooping litter pans as needed.
- Alerting medical or adoption staff if there is a medical issue with any animal in the adoption area.
- Filling water dishes when needed.
- 3 p.m. 5 p.m. shift will be responsible for feeding cats in the colony rooms and will be given special instructions how to do so
- Commitment to mission, values, goals, and success of the SPCA Serving Erie County.

Requirements

- Must be able to bend and lift 30 pounds.
- Must be able to kneel and or get on the ground to retrieve things and get cats out of lower cages.
- Experience with cats and cat behavior is helpful but not required.
- Enthusiastic about caring for felines.
- Must relate well to the staff, volunteers, and guests in the shelter.
- If you are on blood thinners, you should get your Dr's consent before signing on as an FA.
