POSITION SUMMARY AND MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

The SPCA Serving Erie County, located outside of Buffalo, New York, is seeking a passionate and enthusiastic Wildlife Hospital Manager for our thriving Wildlife Department.

This position reports to the Director of Wildlife and is responsible for the overall supervision of medical duties for the Wildlife Hospital. The successful candidate will supervise wildlife staff and volunteers in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws. This dynamic individual will provide, direct, and oversee best practice medical treatments and husbandry care of injured, sick, and orphaned wildlife admitted to the infirmary in coordination with our wildlife veterinarians including triage, anesthesia, radiographs, fracture and wound management, medication calculation and administering euthanasia.

The Wildlife Hospital Manager will network with local rehabilitators to find proper placement for animals and provide medical assistance to these individuals or groups. They will assist in the education of the community on wildlife related issues by developing trainings and events annually for volunteers, interns and local rehabilitators and occasional rescue duties in the community.

The ideal candidate will have a valid NYS driver's license and be a Licensed Veterinary Technician.

They will have at least two years of medical supervisory experience in a wildlife hospital setting and possess problem solving abilities relevant to the nature of our wildlife natural history and must have good interpersonal and communication skills. They will be organized and can delegate duties and multi-task in a fast-paced environment.
