Job Description

For Investigations/Animal Rescue: This person is responsible for transporting any/all animals to the veterinarian and/or other designated destination during their scheduled on-call shift or as needed if available.

For Wildlife: We are looking for volunteers who live all over the county, but especially the southtowns, who can pick up confined, injured wildlife in their area and transport it to the SPCA for evaluation and treatment. This volunteer can have a set schedule or be called when an animal in your area needs help. If possible, SPCA vehicles will be made available for the volunteer to use unless they would rather use their personal vehicle.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities

- Transporting domestic animals to veterinary clinics or shelters
- Transporting wild animals from residences to the SPCA
- Commitment to mission, values, goals, and success of the SPCA Serving Erie County

- Availability on a scheduled shift
- Availability on an as-needed or on-call basis
- Exceptional kindness to all animals, guests, volunteers, and staff per our core mission.
- Willingness to work with and respectfully communicate with all staff and volunteers.
